

Behavior charts for teachers...effective charts to assist in classroom management...

The topics on the following charts can be changed as you deem fit to track behavior in your classroom. These provided address behavior, concentration, and social learning,

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Once the day is finished you summarize the day looking for patterns. These patterns will help you deem what you will add to your weekly summaries.

As the week comes to a close you will transfer the information to the weekly chart. You will be charting any patterns you have found throughout the week. Adding the time of day or activity in the weekly chart can assist you in seeing patterns.

Once one month is complete you will then transfer the information to this chart. You will begin to see patterns in the child's needs; Behavioral, Concentration, and Social learning. Assisting you in designing a program that you KNOW will work, then trying behavioral programs that might be beneficial.

These charts are proven to finding the information needed to design a program that will offer each student the sensory, social language, and behavioral support input that they need.
